

# Town of Prescott Bicentennial - 2010

**A bit of history...** On March 6, 1834, Prescott was proclaimed a Police Village, the document stating "Whereas from the great increase of population in the Town of Prescott, it is necessary to make further provision than by law exists, for the internal regulations". Thus it severed its link with the Township of Augusta. In 1849, it became a separated town, with duly elected Mayor and Council, an administrative arrangement which exists to this day.

**The town of Prescott was named in honour of Robert Prescott, Governor-in-Chief of Canada, 1797-1807.**

By 1835, the population was about 500, and the place was described as one of considerable commercial importance. There were shipyards, wholesale and retail businesses, a foundry for building steam engines, a distillery, pottery and other small firms. The most active was the forwarding trade. The Town of Prescott is celebrating in 2010 its bicentennial, the population has reached in 2010 over 4,200 people.

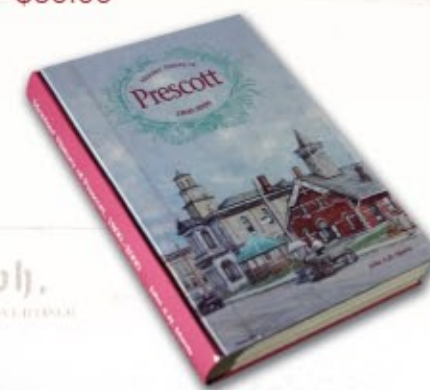
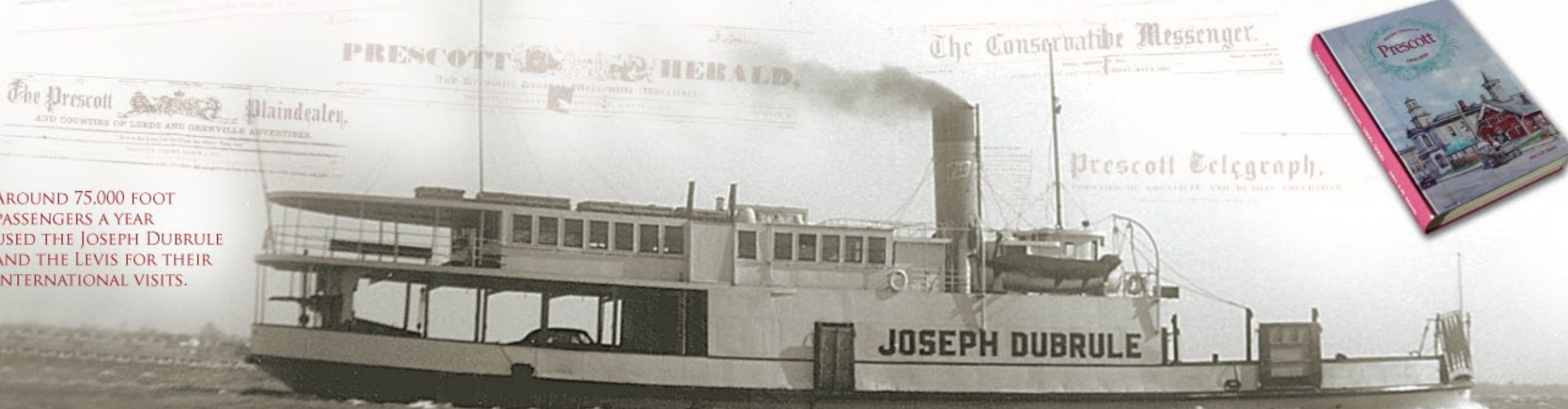
